Modules you may elect to study can provide you with further accreditations and eligibility to join reputable organisations. For example, the International Commercial Arbitration module if passed will grant you eligibility for Associate Membership of the **Chartered Institute of Arbitrators**, allowing you to use the post-nominal letters ACI Arb after your title. This qualification is the first stage towards becoming a chartered arbitrator. The International Commercial Mediation module offers professional benefits as Lancashire Law School has achieved an international reputation for its specialisation in mediation law and practice. This module is approved by the **International Mediation Institute** and so provides you with respected and valuable skills and experience.

This LLM programme is available to those with legal and non-legal backgrounds, with postgraduate students joining with law or business undergraduate experience or professionals joining with legal or commercial industry experience. The range of backgrounds present in our cohort enrich the learning you receive as a member of a diverse learning community.

## Course Highlights

- International Business Law is a broad subject so our course features a range of specialist modules that allow you to customise your qualification and the skills and knowledge you will have gained upon successful completion of the programme.
- Our LLM course offers modules that specialise in increasingly relevant aspects of law such as mediation and arbitration, with successful completion of some modules offering further accreditations/eligibility to join respected legal organisations.
